### A.3 Proposed New Exterior Paint Colors:

Director Ashley Tangeraas discussed the latest choices about the proposal, namely a single color on a home's exterior. The necessity of gathering homeowners' opinions via a survey was discussed. Many have had good results using the software Survey Monkey. The plan now is to have only one single paint color on the exterior of a home. Also, possibly one or two of the current shades might be included.

- 1. **2265 Swarthmore Drive –** Solar tube installation in this 2000 model: Install one Solatube 160 DS/Isn Daylighting 10-in. diameter with the exhaust fan option over the master bathroom toilet & shower room. Contractor is to be JMJ Natural Lighting of Rancho Cordova. This model with the exhaust fan option is contrary to the criteria. The ARC has asked for further information about the installation.
- **B.2. Homeowner Requests Recommended to be Approved:** (With conditions if so noted.) (All votes unanimous unless otherwise noted.)
  - 2. **1545 University Avenue** Retractable awning requested for this 4400 model: Motorized Elite Plus awning with hood measuring 15'6" wide x 13'6" projection. The unit will have the white frame color and Sunbrella fabric in Forrest Green (solid) color, with an 8-in. straight hanging valance with best match (Forrest Green) binding. The contractor is to be Goodwin-Cole. Alan informed the applicant of the possible change to the exterior paint color of the home and the Special Zoning area requirements. **Approval Recommended.**
