CRITERIA FOR CANDIDATES' STATEMENTS

Nepenthe Board Elections 2023

- 1. The Association will copy all candidates' statements received by **March 31** and mail them with the ballots at Association expense.
- 2. It is suggested that candidates include in their statements such information as:
- Length of residency in Nepenthe
- Professional and/or volunteer experience that prepares you to be a Board member (including positions in other organizations, boards and commissions). Please be specific.
- Examples that demonstrate your ability to engage in public discussion, listen to various viewpoints, help resolve disagreements and work toward consensus
- Involvement in Nepenthe Board, committees and/or activities
- What you hope to add to the Board
- Any other relevant information
- 3. The deadline for submitting the statements and photographs for inclusion in the April newsletter and with the mailed ballots is **March 31**.
- 4. The Nepenthe Association retains the right to reject in its entirety any statement that is, in the Board's opinion, slanderous or defamatory.
- 5. Statements must be submitted in PDF format. Color photographs are OK for digital distribution. Photograph should be embedded in the PDF- not submitted as a separate file
- 6. Staff will ensure that candidates do not see each other's' statements until all have been printed in the April newsletter.
- 7. At the bottom of each statement, and within the space allowed, the statement will include this note in a font distinct from, and no smaller than, the font of the body text: "The Nepenthe Association is not responsible for the design or content of the candidates' statements. Distribution of statements does not imply agreement with claims or proposals made in the statements."
- 8. To control costs, statements will be printed in black-and-white only. This includes photographs and any graphic
- 9. Each statement will be printed on a single sheet of white 20-pound stock measuring 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ X 11". Both sides of the sheet may be used.
- Fonts and spacing may be of the candidate's choosing.
